District Attorney Sam Sutter announced today that members of his State Police Drug Unit yesterday seized more than 5,000 Oxycodone and Suboxone pills and arrested a man believed to be a significant Oxycodone trafficker in southeastern Massachusetts.

Roger Levasseur, 29, of 212 Vale St., 3rd floor, was arrested and charged with trafficking more than 200 grams of a class A drug, conspiracy to violate the drug laws and a drug violation in a school zone. Also arrested on a charge of conspiracy to violate the drug laws was Jessica Crowley, 30, of 212 Vale St., 3rd floor.

The two-month long investigation by District Attorney Sutter's State Police Drug Unit, formally known as the Bristol County Drug Task Force, culminated yesterday around noon when several members of the unit executed search warrants at 273 Ames St. and 212 Vale St., 3rd floor. A Fall River Police Detective also assisted in the investigation and search warrant execution.

Inside 273 Ames St., the drug task force located and arrested Mr. Levasseur, who had 4,975-30mg OxyCodone pills on his person. Ms. Crowley was also present at the Ames Street address.

Once inside the Vale Street address, task force members located 30 SubOxone pills and seized more than \$13,000 in cash.

"One of my imperatives at the District Attorney's Office is to target the major drug dealers in this county and build strong cases against them that will result in long prison sentences. I applaud our State Police Drug Task Force Unit for their aggressive work in this case," District Attorney Sutter said.
