District Attorney Sam Sutter announced today that Kimberly Peno, 38, of 19 Blanding Road, Rehoboth, was indicted this week by a Bristol County Grand Jury for the March 18, 2010 First Degree Murder of her 2-year-old son, Timothy Peno.

Mrs. Peno, who is already being held without bail, will be arraigned in the new Fall River Superior Court on July 6th at the new Fall River Superior Court, located at 186 South Main Street.

On March 18th at 12:15 a.m., Timothy Peno's father entered the Seekonk Police and Fire Headquarters seeking assistance for his severely injured son. Mrs. Peno was also present outside the station.

Seekonk paramedics rendered immediate aid to the child and transported him to Hasbro Children's Hospital in providence, RI for further treatment. Seekonk Police determined the injuries were sustained at the child's residence, 19 Blanding Road in Rehoboth, and contacted Rehoboth Police. An investigation was launched by members of District Attorney Sutter's State Police Unit, Rehoboth Police and Seekonk Police.

Timothy Peno was pronounced dead several hours after arriving at the hospital.

The case against Mrs. Peno will be prosecuted by Second Assistant District Attorney Silvia Rudman and Assistant District Attorney Marni Peck.
