The victim of the recent Fall River elder abuse case died today at St. Anne's Hospital in Fall River. The 81-year-old victim has been identified as Mary Araujo, of 161 Lonsdale St. in Fall River. Today was Ms. Araujo's 81st birthday.

The state Medical Examiner's Office will take custody of the body either later today or tomorrow morning and an autopsy should be conducted sometime this weekend.

No determination regarding the potential for upgraded charges against the five family members already charged with crimes associated with this case will be made at this time. Because the investigation into this matter remains open and pending, no further comment will be made at this time.

The five family members already charged in connection with this case are:

Duarte Cabral, 51, of 161 Lonsdale St., charged with permitting injury to an elderly or disabled person and permitting serious injury to an elderly or disabled person.

Karen Cabral, 49, of 161 Lonsdale St., charged with permitting injury to an elderly or disabled person and permitting serious injury to an elderly or disabled person.

Corey Cabral, 21, of 161 Lonsdale St., charged with permitting injury to an elderly or disabled person and permitting serious injury to an elderly or disabled person.

Scott Cabral, 24, of 161 Lonsdale St., charged with permitting injury to an elderly or disabled person and permitting serious injury to an elderly or disabled person.

Keith Cabral, 29, of 161 Lonsdale St., charged with elder neglect-serious injury.
