District Attorney Sam Sutter announced this morning that fugitive murder suspect Michael V. Feliciano was captured in Sturbridge around 2:15 a.m.

Feliciano, 17, of 78 Swift St., New Bedford, was arrested by members of the state police unit assigned to the district attorney's office during a traffic stop.

Feliciano will be arraigned this morning in New Bedford District Court on a charge of murder. He is accused of killing Albon Wilson in New Bedford during the early evening hours of September 30th. Mr. Wilson, of New Bedford, was found shot to death at the corner of Bonney and Thompson streets.

More details of the case and the search for Feliciano will be revealed during this morning's arraignment. First Assistant District Attorney Bill McCauley, chief of the office's Homicide Unit, will prosecute the case for the commonwealth.

The case was investigated by the Massachusetts State Police Unit assigned to the Bristol County District Attorney's Office, New Bedford Police and the U.S. Marshals.
