Bristol County District Attorney Sam Sutter announced today that an arrest has been made in connection to the January 20, 2010 murder of 19-year-old Arthur Burton in New Bedford and that investigators are actively seeking a second suspect who is wanted for the murder.

At approximately 8:40 p.m. on January 20th, New Bedford Police were contacted regarding a man lying on the ground in the backyard of a home at 192 Purchase St. Upon arrival, police discovered the man was deceased and was the victim of a gun shot wound to the head. The victim was later identified as Arthur Burton, 19, of New Bedford.

During the ensuing two months, investigators with District Attorney Sutter's State Police Unit and detectives from the New Bedford Police Department have been engaged in an extensive investigation into the killing. The investigation has been coordinated for District Attorney Sutter's office by his Co-First Assistant District Attorney, William McCauley.

Tyrone Solano, 20, of New Bedford, was arrested in New Bedford yesterday on charges of Accessory to Murder, Intimidation of a Witness and Perjury. He will be arraigned on these charges Monday morning in New Bedford District Court.

An arrest warrant has also been lodged against Seth Andrade, 19, of New Bedford. Mr. Andrade is wanted on a charge of murder. He is known to frequent the south end of New Bedford, but also has ties in Fall River, Brockton and Freetown. A wanted poster is attached to this e-mail.

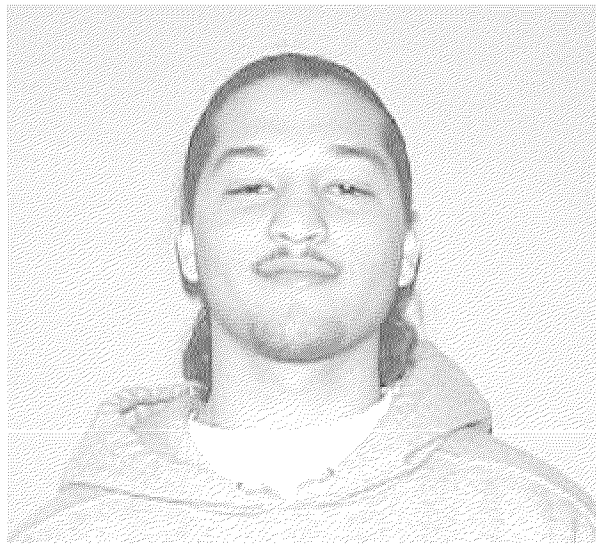
District Attorney Sutter and New Bedford Police Chief Ronald Teachman are asking for the public's assistance in locating Mr. Andrade. The public is urged not to approach Mr. Andrade or attempt to subdue him. He may be armed and could be dangerous.
