Bristol County District Attorney Sam Sutter announced today that Seth Andrade, 19, of New Bedford, was arrested by state and local police inside a home at 74 Raymond Street, Fall River, early this morning. Mr. Andrade was being sought for the January 20, 2010 murder of 19-year-old Arthur Burton in New Bedford.

At approximately 8:40 p.m. on January 20th, New Bedford Police were contacted regarding a man lying on the ground in the backyard of a home at 192 Purchase St. Upon arrival, police discovered the man was deceased and was the victim of a gunshot wound to the head. The victim was later identified as Arthur Burton, 19, of New Bedford.

During the ensuing two months, investigators with District Attorney Sutter's State Police Unit and detectives from the New Bedford Police Department have been engaged in an extensive investigation into the killing. The investigation has been coordinated for District Attorney Sutter's office by his Co-First Assistant District Attorney, William McCauley.

Tyrone Solano, 20, of New Bedford, was arrested in New Bedford Friday on charges of Accessory to Murder, Intimidation of a Witness and Perjury. He will be arraigned on these charges Monday morning in New Bedford District Court.

Seth Andrade, 19, of New Bedford is now charged with murder and carrying an illegal firearm. Mr. Andrade will also be arraigned on these charges Monday morning in New Bedford District Court.
