District Attorney Sam Sutter announced today that Ramon Lowman, 28, of Plainville, was convicted of armed assault to murder, aggravated assault and battery, assault and battery with a dangerous weapon, and unlawful distribution of a class C drug.

Mr. Lowman was sentenced by Judge Barbara Dortch-Okara to serve no less than 15 years in state prison, to be followed by 10 years of supervised probation.

Mr. Lowman was convicted of slicing his live-in girlfriend from ear to ear, stabbing her twice in the chest, slashing both her wrists, and breaking her nose and cheekbone.

Second Assistant District Attorney Silvia Rudman prosecuted the case for District Attorney Sutter's office.
