Bristol County District Attorney Sam Sutter will be joined this Thursday afternoon by his entire team of prosecutors, senior staff members and more than two dozen social service agency representatives to announce the details of a major volunteer initiative at the District Attorney's Office.

The press conference will be held tomorrow at 2:15 p.m. in the Atrium/Lobby at the District Attorney's Office, located at 888 Purchase Street in New Bedford.

District Attorney Sutter promised during last year's campaign to do more with Community Outreach and to spend less money from the District Attorney's budget doing it. By creating partnerships that will team his 48 prosecutors and six senior staff members with 25 different volunteer-based social service organizations, the District Attorney has followed through on that pledge.

The volunteer initiative being announced tomorrow on the ground level of the District Attorney's Office will affect programs in the Attleboro, Fall River, New Bedford and Taunton areas.

"This volunteer initiative is equally important to all of the other initiative we have embarked upon at the District Attorney's Office this year; initiatives like unsolved homicides, major violators and wiretaps. The modern District Attorney's Office is about more than just going into courtrooms and getting convictions, and tough sentences. It is about taking action to prevent crime. I look forward to releasing the details of this volunteer initiative tomorrow."
